The meeting was called to order by the President at 7:40pm. The minutes from the previous meeting were tabled until the next meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE – no report.

HIGH SCHOOL – Dorothy Estey presented the report. The next scheduled meet is at DSC on Wednesday for District 1 and there are three scheduled district meets in March. There is an average of 10 teams per district with about 100 skaters in the district. Michelle has sent a job description to Kathy for posting.

NEW BUSINESS

There is discussion that Nationals will be hosted in Metro Detroit in 2010 and DSC has been contacted to host. Possible trouble with hotel accommodations was discussed as there will be a need for 375 rooms. The bid packet will be released in April. Compulsory Dance and Short Programs would be skated at DSC. Long Program and Finals would be skated at the Palace. 33,000 volunteer hours were logged when DSC hosted in 1994 with a net profit of \$750,000.00. There has been additional talk of moving Nationals to mid December and Regionals would move to August.

OLD BUSINESS

IJS PROPOSAL – The equipment has been ordered and some has been delivered. There will be a brief training session in Garden City on March 14th. Details TBA.
